Hope all is well and Khoj is on track. Concerned as I have not heard about proposals and progress from anyone; though Sumit (Bhawal) has been keeping me informed about as few BSc proposals. Please send me update and examples of proposals so we can discuss if students are on the right track.

From Sumit's mail, the proposals I have seen are weak, uninnovative and do not establish a social connect. There are three problems I see - students keep on providing solution that have no real connection to Indian social context; they keep putting cart before the horse or a solution with a real problem; and most may qualify "innovation" (if done well) but they are not real social innovation. You need to remind the students of the criteria I have sent before and unless they fulfill those criteria, they will not pass.

In the solution they provide, there has to be a strong evidence of where/how the problem has been derived; solve a real-life problem (because that is more important than finding an excellent solution. The solution must solve a social problem and not just some (esoteric) problem. The solution needs to be original and developed; not just out of website; evidence of development must be there. And the solution must be scalable so as to create a social enterprise.

4. Limit the number of slides to 7-8.
5. Add photographs of your field visits to make your PPT more effective.
6. Avoid reading from the PPT. That said, avoid including long paragraphs. Just mention the points and explain orally.
7. The members should have more or less equal contribution in presenting. Avoid the situation wherein only one member is presenting and the rest are just standing there.
8. Record the feedback received from Provost sir and other faculties. Mention the same when you come next time.

Respected Sir,

Following points cover the feedback and suggestions for improvement for KHOJ as discussed in the Final Evaluation session (7th December 2017):

1. The overall progress of KHOJ was found better as compared to KHOJ 2016.
2. Need was felt to provide a broad theme based area to the students so that they can work on the same. Ideas that are found repetitive in nature needs to be refined by the mentors.
3. To ensure that the entire KHOJ project is accomplished in time, each phase should be completed within a designated timeline.
4. To motivate the students for performing better, it was suggested that a pinch of competitive attitude needs to be added. Hence, proposal of awarding the "Best KHOJ project" was put on the table.
5. For making their presentations more effective and avoid "copy-pasting", students should be asked to present video evidences of their visits to the community.
6. In case the student (s) has not worked appropriately and deserves an "F" grade then that student (s) will have to re-submit the entire project. The non-active students can form a group.
7. A separate session of 1 hour should be engaged every week to track the work-in-progress of the groups.
8. Selected projects with good ideas can be carried forward by the next KHOJ groups i.e. KHOJ 2018 groups.
9. Selected KHOJ projects can be displayed on the website of Navrachana University so as to bring about a positive visual appeal to the visitors.

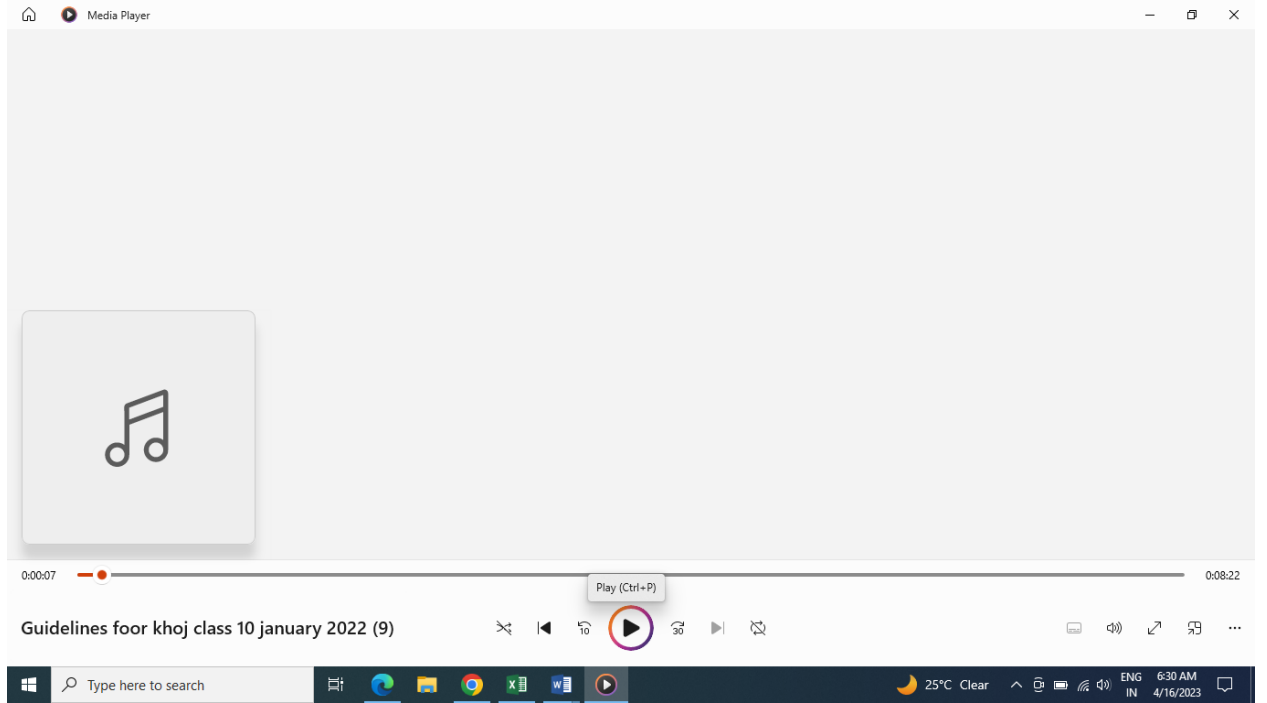

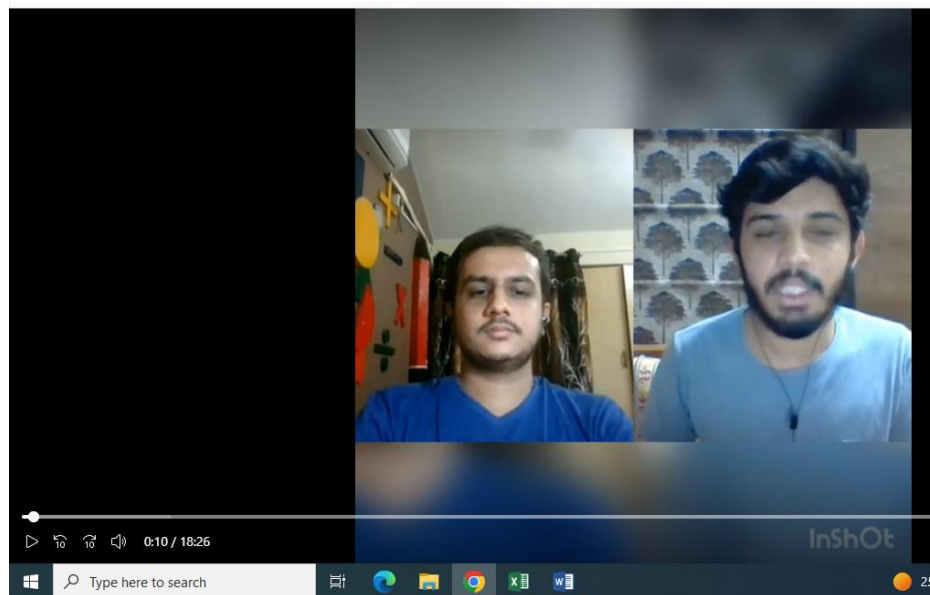
