Initially, the club meetings consisted of movie screenings followed by discussions on that movie. In addition to that, now the club also partakes in other activities. For example, in August, 2020, the club hosted competitions like Funtakshari (innovative take on antakshari) and cinema quiz. The club plans to write weekly movie reviews under the name of 'Filmy Fridays' and refurbish video collages from available movie clips into a whole new story in the future.

The Mehfilm Club Members add a whole new dimension to the program and are the people to look for to understand Christopher Nolan's films.

TV CLUB

With the idea of giving students the experience of working behind a real Television Show, the TV Club of Navrachana University, NUVISION was launched in 2019 at the 'Event Buzzar' by the Journalism and Mass Communication program.

It started with reporting hard news about the city and campus to the students but with time it has shifted more towards the infotainment format.

In the process, students not only learnt how to develop news stories and script a show but they also had to work with various professional equipment like the green screen, DSLR camera, lapel mic etc. and how to mix the audio and video via software's like adobe premiere pro.

On ground reporting, scheduling interviews, managing people involved in the project and meeting the deadlines were things that the students were able to accomplish in a month's time.

Students got various opportunities to visit and interact with various Radio professionals, including top RJs of the city and the Programming Directors, which helped the students understand the nuances of radio in real life.
